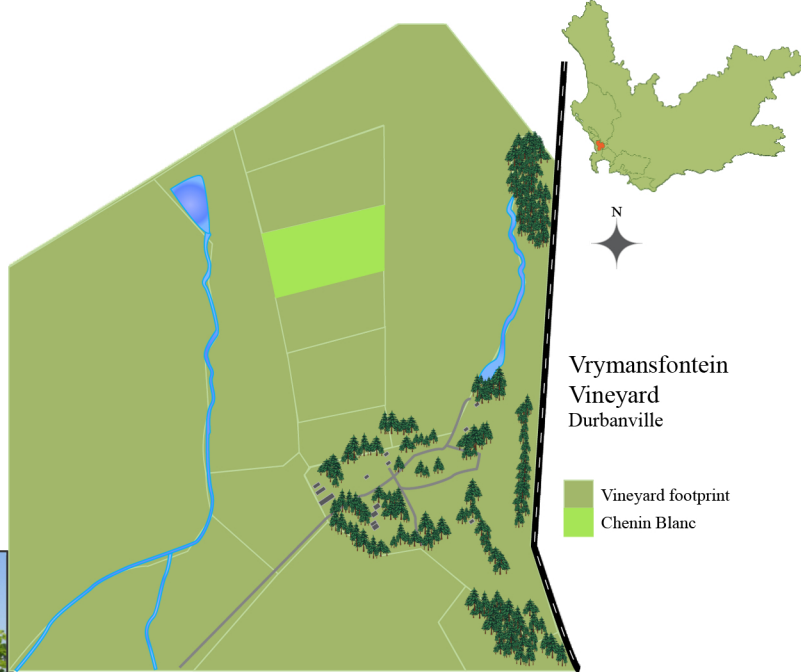


## TYGERBERG

Durbanville, a ward of Tygerberg, borders the northern suburbs of Cape Town in close proximity to the Atlantic. Vines are cultivated on slopes reaching elevations of up to 1,100 feet, and the altitude, in concert with cool ocean winds, evening fogs and deep soils yield a spectrum of high quality varietals. At these altitudes soils are primarily granite and sandstone, and precipitation falls within a fairly narrow 360 to 500mm annually (14 to 20 inches). The Chenin Blanc plot from



which Adoro sources its fruit is twenty years old and unirrigated, whereas the Sauvignon Blanc is from an irrigated twelve year old block, both in the Vrymansfontein vineyard.
